Start Presentation

2 Corinthians 5:17, Galatians 2:20 Spiritual Death & Rebirth

Therefore if any person is in Christ he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old previous moral and spiritual condition has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come! [AMP]

My old identity has been co-crucified with Messiah and no longer lives; for the nails of his cross crucified me with him. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. [TPT]

Galatians 3:24, Romans 7:4, Colossians 2:13-14

Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another—to Him who was raised from the dead.

He has made you alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

So now the case is closed. There remains no accusing voice of condemnation against those who are joined in life-union with Jesus, the Anointed One. [TPT]

With the arrival of Jesus, the Messiah, that fateful dilemma is resolved. Those who enter into Christ's beinghere-for-us no longer have to live under a continuous, low-lying black cloud. [Message]

2 Corinthians 3:9

For if the ministry of condemnation had glory, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much more in glory.

If the old way, which brings condemnation, was glorious, how much more glorious is the new way, which makes us right with God! [NLT]

If the Government of Condemnation was impressive, how about this Government of Affirmation? Bright as that old government was, it would look downright dull alongside this new one. If that makeshift arrangement impressed us, how much more this brightly shining government installed for eternity? [Message]



Continual Cleansing In The Face of Failure

1 John 1:6-9 Continual Cleansing

If we claim that we share life with him, but keep walking in the realm of darkness, we're fooling ourselves and not living the truth.

But if we keep living in the pure light that surrounds him, we share unbroken fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, continually cleanses us from all sin.

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 3:20

For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.

Even if we feel guilty, God is greater than our feelings, and he knows everything. [NLT]

Whenever our hearts make us feel guilty and remind us of our failures, we know that God is much greater and more merciful than our conscience, and he knows everything there is to know about us. [TPT]

Hebrews 4:15-16, 9:14

For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Continual Consideration In The Face of Temptation

Romans 6:6,11 Continual Consideration

We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin.

So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus. [NLT]

So let it be the same way with you! Since you are now joined with him, you must continually view yourselves as dead and unresponsive to sin's appeal while living daily for God's pleasure in union with Jesus, the Anointed One. [TPT]

2 Corinthians 5:16-17 The Specific Consideration

Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

The old previous moral and spiritual condition has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!

Romans 7:22-23, 8:12, 6:7 The Identity Attack

I delight in the law of God according to the inward man, but I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation to do what your sinful nature urges (wars) you to do.

Could it be any clearer? Our old way of life was nailed to the cross with Christ, a decisive end to that sin-miserable life—no longer at sin's every beck and call!

Colossians 3:9, Ephesians 4:23-24, Romans 12:2

Put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him

Be renewed in the spirit of your mind and put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Continual Filling In The Face of Weakness

Ephesians 5:18-20, Colossians 3:2, Acts 2:4

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Yes, feast on all the treasures of the heavenly realm and fill your thoughts with heavenly realities, and not with the distractions of the natural realm.

And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

Psalm 23:1-3, Matthew 11:28-29 The Act of Filling Up

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters.

He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Galatians 5:22-23

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!
