Answering His Call

Matthew 11:28-30

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

Luke 10:39-42

Mary, sat at the Lord's feet, listening to what he taught.

But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me."

And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things.

But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

Matthew 26:37-39, Luke 22:43

He took Peter and Zebedee's two sons, James and John, and he became anguished and distressed.

He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."

He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

Hebrews 4:15-16

Psalms 91:14-16

Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.

He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.

With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation. Philippians 4:4,6-8

Matthew 11:29-30

29 Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly." [Message]

29 Learn my ways and you'll discover that I'm gentle, humble, easy to please. You will find refreshment and rest in me. [Passion]

Colossians 3:15

And let the peace which comes from Christ rule (act as umpire continually) in your hearts [deciding and settling with finality all questions that arise in your minds, in that peaceful state] to which as members of Christ's one body you were also called. And be thankful (appreciative), [giving praise to God always]. Hebrews 12:12-13

Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed. Psalm 126:1-3,5
