Above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.


And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God




James 4:7

Hebrew 4:12

For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power making it active, operative, energizing, and effective... [AMP]

Breastplate of Righteousness The Grace of God

Ephesians 4:23-24

And be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

And be constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude], and put on the new nature created in God's image, [Godlike] in true righteousness and holiness. [AMP] Romans 5:17-19, 21 Your Righteousness Is A Gift!

For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life.

For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 6:10-11 A New Creation

Therefore if any person is in Christ he is a new creation; the old previous moral and spiritual condition has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!

When he died, he died once to break the power of sin. But now that he lives, he lives for the glory of God.

So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus.

1 John 3:20, Hebrews 4:16, 1 John 1:9, Hebrews 9:14

Even if we feel guilty, God is greater than our feelings, and he knows everything.

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Gospel of Peace The Love of God

Acts 16:22-24

A mob quickly formed against Paul and Silas, and the city officials ordered them stripped and beaten with wooden rods.

They were severely beaten, and then they were thrown into prison. The jailer was ordered to make sure they didn't escape.

So the jailer put them into the inner dungeon and clamped their feet in the stocks.

Acts 16:25-28

Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. Suddenly, there was a massive earthquake, and the prison was shaken to its foundations. All the doors immediately flew open, and the chains of every prisoner fell off!

The jailer woke up to see the prison doors wide open. He assumed the prisoners had escaped, so he drew his sword to kill himself. But Paul shouted to him, "Stop! Don't kill yourself! We are all here!"

Acts 16:29-32

The jailer called for lights and ran to the dungeon and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. Then he brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household."

And they shared the word of the Lord with him and with all who lived in his household.

Colossians 3:12-14, Ephesians 4:31-32

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice.

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Philippians 2:3-4

Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. [NKJ]

Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.

Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. [NLT]
